March 18, 2019

A REGULAR MEETING OF THE TRAFFIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TSAC) WAS HELD ON THE ABOVE DATE IN THE SARGE LITTLEHALE COMMUNITY ROOM, 22 ORINDA WAY, ORINDA, CALIFORNIA.

A. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Bisesto called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

B. ROLL CALL

COMMITTEEMEMBERS: Laura Bisesto, Stuart House, Mark Roberts, Steve Schnier

City Staff: Director of Public Works and Engineering Services Larry Theis; Assistant Engineer Kevin McCourt; Police Officer David Sandy

Chair Bisesto introduced and welcomed newly appointed Committeemember Stuart House. Committeemember House currently is the Director of Facilities, Maintenance, and Operations for the Orinda Union School District and has served in government at the Federal, State, and local levels; his primary interest is traffic safety for children.

C. TRAFFIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

February 11, 2019

MOTION: By Committeemember Roberts, seconded by Committeemember Schnier, to approve the TSAC Meeting Minutes of February 11, 2019. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

D. PUBLIC FORUM – None

E. DISCUSSION – BIKE RODEO/BICYCLE SAFETY DAY

Chair Bisesto advised that she had attended the March 5, 2019, City Council meeting and had spoken in support of the Bike Rodeo/Bicycle Safety Day. A permit for the event to be held at Wagner Ranch Elementary School is currently being processed. *Bike East Bay* will be organizing the event and creating a flyer for distribution.

The City Council approved an expenditure of \$4,000 for the event, which is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. to Noon, Saturday, May 11, 2019, at Wagner Ranch Elementary School.

Committeemember House noted that the School District could advertise the event in their newsletter.

Director Theis added that staff would post the flyer in the City Outlook and on NextDoor.

F. TRAFFIC CALMING UPDATES AND ACTIONS

1. Briefing from Police Chief – SLOW DOWN ORINDA/Traffic Citations Report
Officer Sandy provided the February 2019 Traffic Enforcement Statistics for moving and parking violations.

Committeemember House commented that each year Miramonte High School students drive particularly hazardously on the last day of school in June.

Officer Sandy stated that there are currently no plans to increase the number of officers on duty that day; the Police Department is aware of the issue and will endeavor to enforce appropriately; he added that he will communicate those concerns to the Department.

Committeemember House inquired about the issuance of traffic citations for illegally passing School Buses.

Officer Sandy indicated that most citations are for drivers traveling in the opposite direction who ignore the flashing lights and extended Stop sign which the School Bus activates when picking up and dropping off students.

2. Traffic Calming Requests - None

3. Accessibility Issues

Director Theis noted that Nick Waranoff, Orinda resident, had requested an update on staff progress with the ADA Transition Plan; staff will be recommending an increase to the current \$10,000 budget for ADA Ramp funding during the upcoming Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) discussions with the City Council, which begin April 23, 2019; there are currently an additional 20 projects for CIP discussion, including the Moraga Way Walkway.

Assistant Engineer McCourt stated that the previously reviewed pedestrian ramps on Santa Maria Way at Altarinda Road are currently scheduled to be constructed this summer during the 2019 Pavement Rehabilitation Project.

G. STAFF REPORT

1. *Update – Current Balance of Traffic Calming Improvements Program
FY 2019 expenditures \$7,775.96 to date; \$40,000 budget = remaining balance
\$32,224.04*

Director Theis advised that the TSAC budget will be addressed during the upcoming CIP discussions; the TSAC budget, which is funded by the Gas Tax, was originally \$25,000 and subsequently increased to \$40,000; it has been difficult to spend the allotted funds as the majority of the Traffic Calming Requests have been put on hold; the City is requesting an additional Engineer position which may help with department workload, although the primary duties for the new position will be strategic priorities, downtown development, and creek issues.

Committeemember House noted a school route project in Walnut Creek that was funded by the County's *Area Benefit Fees* and inquired whether there was a way to use the City's or County's benefit fees to fund such projects in Orinda.

Director Theis explained that Orinda would not have access to County benefit fees; however, Orinda does receive Lamorinda *Area Benefit Fees* which the City uses for various projects.

2. *Update – Rheem Boulevard - Radar Speed Sign Installation*

Assistant Engineer McCourt advised that he had notified the Neighborhood Action Team (NAT) that this item will be pulled from consideration if they are not prepared to move forward; the NAT will discuss and contact staff.

Committeemember House informed staff that a radar feedback sign on Glorietta Boulevard was not operational.

Director Theis confirmed that staff will check the malfunctioning sign.

3. *Update - Hillcrest Drive (between Martha Road and Overhill Road) – Speed Cushion Installation and Radar Speed Sign Installation*

Assistant Engineer McCourt advised that this item is moving forward to determine a date for an NAT meeting.

Committeemember House inquired whether the request could be expanded to include safe driving education for parents of Glorietta Elementary School students; perhaps the use of the school's marquee to advise slower driving would be beneficial.

Assistant Engineer McCourt noted that Kirsten Slawson, Orinda resident, had submitted the initial request and has previously stated that the Principal of Glorietta Elementary School has sent notices to parents regarding safe driving; additionally, residents in the neighborhood have stood in front of their homes and held up signs requesting that drivers slow down.

4. *Postponed - Donald Drive – Signage and Speed Cushion Installation (ON HOLD)*
No update.

5. *Postponed – Rheem Boulevard at Zander Drive– 3-Way Stop Sign (ON HOLD)*
Assistant Engineer McCourt advised this item is no longer on hold and is moving forward; notices will be sent to residents within 500' of the intersection regarding the Stop sign request; additionally, he will notify the Town of Moraga and create a flyer for distribution; once feedback is received, staff will present the request to the City Council.

6. *Postponed – East Altarinda Road– Signage (ON HOLD)*
No update.

7. *Postponed – Northwood Drive – Speed Cushion Request (ON HOLD)*
No update.

8. *Postponed – Lost Valley Drive – Signage/Striping/Radar Feedback Request (ON HOLD)*
No update.

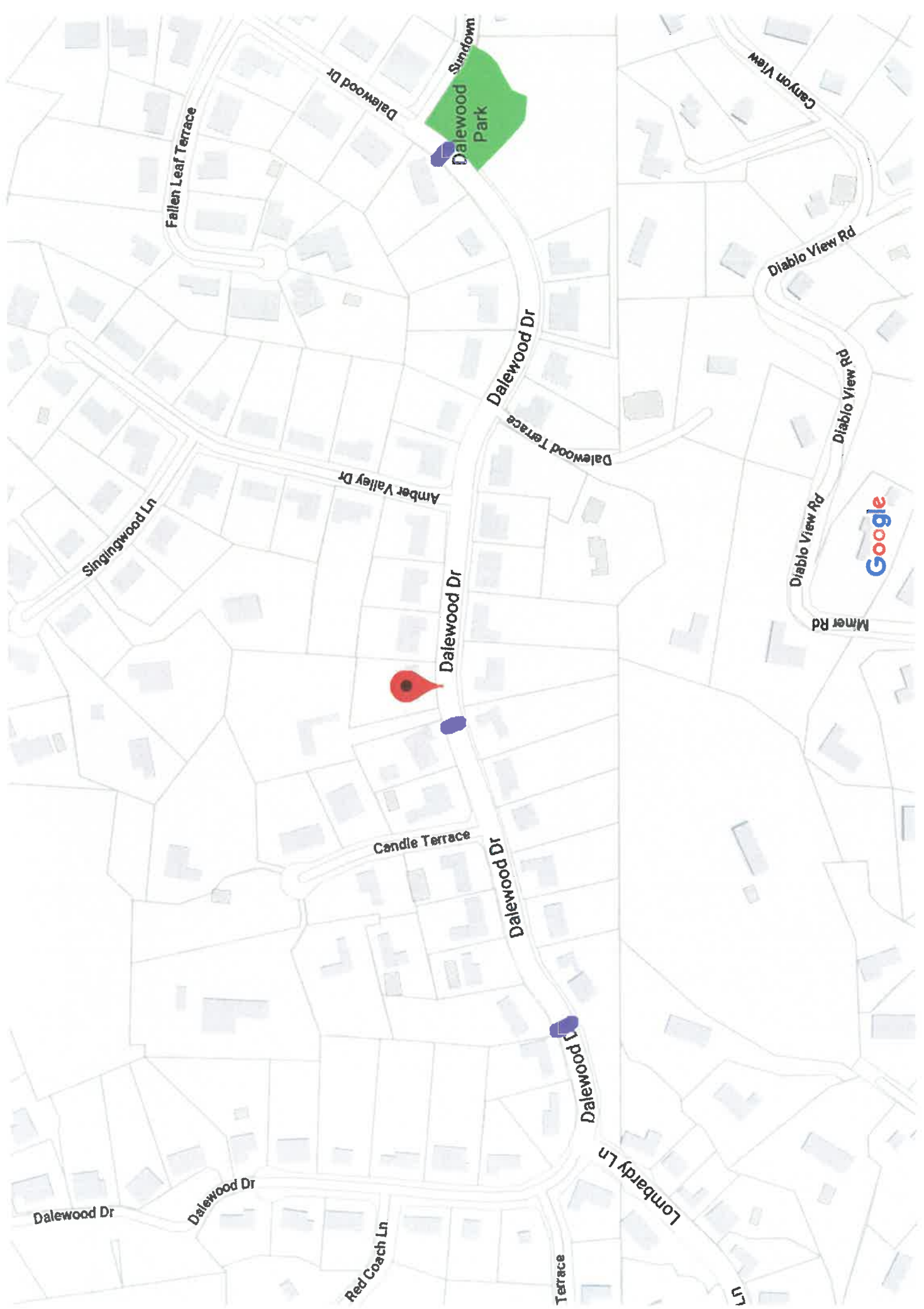
