



# Moraga-Orinda Fire District

The annual exterior hazard compliance deadline is **May 31, 2022**. The abatement requirements include:

1. Cut annual grasses and weeds to a height of 3" or less
2. Maintain the roadside free of encroaching hazardous vegetation within 3' horizontally and 15' vertically from edge of roadway
3. Thin or remove concentrations of non-irrigated brush
4. Remove Ladder fuels to create at least a 6' air gap between the lower portions of tree canopy and the ground or ground fuel
5. Remove all dead or dying trees
6. Remove all ground litter
7. Remove all combustible ground cover within 2' of a structure to include Mulch & Bark. List of approved ground cover: <https://www.mofd.org/home/showdocument?id=1376>
8. Create at least a 1' air gap between the ground and lower portion of bushes, privets, and other decorative plants within 2' of structures
9. Create 6' of vertical clearance between tree canopy and roofs
10. Remove Eucalyptus and Monterey Pine within 6' of structures
11. Remove Juniper and Bamboo within 10' of a road by the end of 2023
12. Maintain the roof of any structure and roof gutters free of leaves, needles, or hazardous vegetation and other combustible materials
13. Maintain areas underneath decks free of hazardous vegetation and combustible material
